Lower guidelines prevent the participants from qualifying for necessary services; such as, inpatient treatment. Previous CCW convictions are considered for UDCI referrals only.</p>	<p>Violent/sexual/weapons offenses are disqualified from participation</p>	<p>24 months; 3 phases</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Veteran's Treatment Court</p>	<p>Any military discharge other than dishonorable is accepted. There is a connection between the veterans' criminal offense and his/her mental &/or physical injury from service</p>	<p>Violent/sexual offenses are disqualified from participation as described in MCL 600.1200(m)</p>	<p>24 months; 5 phases</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Mental Health Court</p>	<p>Must be severely and persistently mentally ill; eligible for Mental Health Diversion programs or are Mental Health Diversion probation violators</p>	<p>No assaultive charges. Low level assault cases considered on a case by case basis. No OUIL cases that require mandatory jail time. No high level developmentally disabled clients.</p>	<p>18 months plus an additional year of probation for monitoring; 4 phases, approximately 4-5 months each</p>

<p>Swift and Sure Sanctions Probation Program</p>	<p>Probationer has to have at least 12 months of probation time to serve, a COMPAS score of 8 or higher, and at least 3 prior probation violations.</p>	<p>Anyone who doesn't meet the programs criteria.</p>	<p>12 months minimum; 3 phases</p>
<p>Restorative Justice Pilot Program</p>	<p>Auto theft cases only; under age 21; no prior convictions</p>	<p>Anyone who doesn't meet the programs criteria.</p>	<p>N/A</p>
